Youlgrave Parish Council manages Alport Lane Playing Fields on behalf of Fields in Trust and Holywell Lane Public Toilet Block on behalf of the charity. The charity holds the assets and all funding and management is provided at cost to Youlgrave Parish Council which offsets any income directly attributable to the assets against running costs and provides the balance of funds from the precept to ensure the charity does not make a loss.

Provision of a playing field and recreation ground along with amenities for public use.

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

The Parish Council maintains and renews the assets as well as enhancing this by provision of specific items for play and exercise from its funds to give added value to the public use. The field areas are open year round and toilet blocks for as much of the year as council deems safe from the extremes of weather or closure for essential maintenance. Regular inspections of the facilities are carried out and Council encourages team sports by provision of dedicated areas for football and cricket with a pavilion available for team use. It also leases an area to the Bowls Club for their pavilion and green. The primary school uses the field for activities as they have no grass areas.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Queen Elizabeth II Alport Lane Playing Fields

This area is used by the Football, Cricket and Bowls Clubs and by Youlgrave School and the Youlgrave Carnival on an organised basis; as well as being used throughout the seasons as a safe play area for village children and visitors alike.

Improvements have been carried out to enhance the experience of user of this valuable facility.

 Provision by Council of Air Fitness equipment – continues to be used and now supplemented by a bench to encourage companions to join the users.

BMX trail – refurbished.. Childrens play area fence replaced. Noted pavilion reaching end of life.

Holywell Lane Toilet Block

Well used by walkers – one toilet replaced and drain works carried out due to overuse by hundreds of visitors to the swimming area.
