The Parish Council maintains and renews the assets as well as enhancing this by provision of specific items for play and exercise from its funds to give added value to the public use. The field areas are open year round and toilet blocks for as much of the year as council deems safe from the extremes of weather or closure for essential maintenance. Regular inspections of the facilities are carried out and Council encourages team sports by provision of dedicated areas for football and cricket with a pavilion available for team use. It also leases an area to the Bowls Club for their pavilion. The primary school uses the field for activities as they have no grass areas.

Queen Elizabeth II Alport Lane Playing Fields

This area is used by the Football, Cricket and Bowls Clubs and by Youlgrave School and the Youlgrave Fun Day on an organised basis; as well as being used throughout the seasons as a safe play area for village children and visitors alike.

The Pommie Panter raised funds for the field by use as a one day car park for those taking part – this is set to become an annual event. Improvements have been carried out to enhance the experience of users of this valuable facility. CCTV has been installed on the Pavilion and Toilet Block and power laid on to the toilet block.
